SECTION B HUNTERS AND FLAT CLASSES		
1. Turnout and Showmanship Handlers will be marked on the horse and handler's turn out, and correct handling practices \$10		
2. Lead line class – Riders who are under 6 years of age and require a handler. Both Rider and handler will be judged on correct handling and position of rider. Riders may trot if all are able to perform while being lead. \$10		
3. Walk trot equitation. (under 12 years). Riders will be judged on correct English equitation position. \$7.00		
4. Walk trot pleasure (under 12 years) \$ 7.00		
5. Junior equitation (12 years and over) \$7.00		
6. Senior equitation (12 years and over) \$ 7.00		
7. Junior pleasure \$ 7.00

Negative Coggins required in advance of show. This is a day show, tie to your trailer please or book a stall well in advance (limited stall availability/barn use). No dogs please. Registrations with payment must be received prior to arrival (email or drop off show forms). Entries due by May 20th, late fee of \$10 if received after that date. Full refund with Veterinary note. Early entry discount. Show will run indoors if inclement weather. Hot lunch available. Competitors will be issued numbers when waiver and entry forms are received in the Show Office. Please enclose a completed Release and Waiver of Liability form with your entry form and fees. The management committee reserves the right to remove any groom, owner, trainer, manager, or rider from the horse show without compensation should that individual exhibit dangerous or unsportsmanlike behavior or harm to a horse. Any acts of discourtesy, or disobediences to the judges or officials by the owner, rider, manager, trainer, or groom shall disqualify them from further competition in the horse show and the owner shall forfeit all fees. Inhumane treatment of a horse including polling, rapping, or other abuse shall not be tolerated. Violation of this rule shall result in immediate disqualification, and forfeiture of all fees and prizes. It is mandatory that all persons mounted on a horse anywhere on the competition grounds wear protective headgear secured with a safety harness permanently affixed to the helmet. Junior competitors must wear properly fitted, approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured at all times while mounted on the competition or event grounds. Approved headgear must be certified by SEI or another testing body that it meets the American Society for Testing Materials (ASTM) standard or the British Standards Institution (BSI) standard. Juniors not complying with this rule will not be allowed to compete in competitions that require approved headgear. Hunter Ring – braiding and hunt jackets recommended but not required. Hunter warm-up rounds are available for \$15.00. Group times may be booked. Please call 306.230-5823 to reserve a time slot. Riders may enter no more than two consecutive height levels.
